We aim to create the conditions for sustainable working and will strive to ensure that Townsend Theatre Production's employees, freelance team and directors work in low-carbon, efficient environments, and that our work and operations use the minimum of resources and produce a minimum of waste

Our Industry

Our ambition is to contribute to a more sustainable cultural industry by sharing data and good practice, and by collaborating with others in the sector

Our Audience and Participants

We hope that our audiences will understand Townsend Theatre Productions decision process and contribution to a sustainable world and will feel informed and inspired about the contribution they can make as individuals.

Our actions and commitments

- We plan to collect and analyse data to understand our environmental impact and to develop a strategy to mitigate that impact.
- We are keeping a materials inventory for the **new show** as outlined in the **Theatre Green Book** to create a baseline of data from which to understand the physical footprint of our shows.
- We encourage our staff, directors, partners and participants and the public to adopt environmentally sustainable practices themselves .
- A sustainability champion will use the collected data and Julie's Bicycle's creative green tools to produce an annual report on Townsend Theatre Productions environmental impact.
